



















New Aluminations issue

Nikon's Small World competition: see the winning images


<u>Nikon's Small World</u> is regarded as the leading forum for showcasing the beauty and complexity of life as seen through the light microscope.

Search Tip: Highlight and comment in Google Scholar PDF reader

<u>Google Scholar PDF Reader</u>, a browser extension from the Chrome store, allows you to mark key passages or make notes as you read.

Select the text you want to emphasize, and a popup will appear, allowing you to choose a highlight colour or add a comment.

Highlights and comments are saved automatically to your personal Google Scholar Library.

The cloud icon confirms your notes are saved online. Access them from any device when logged into your Google account.

You can view all your highlights and comments in the PDF, and also see them in your Scholar library.

Other functions include: Al Outline for quick overview; one-click preview of cited articles; linked figure and table mentions; citing and related articles; and light/dark modes.

High blood pressure rates in children nearly doubled in 20 years, global review finds: Poor diet, inactivity and obesity believed to have caused hypertension for millions of under-19s around the world. [The Guardian]



- → How a 'swimming cap' could transform care for brain-injured babies: Researchers say they are the first in the world to trial a new technique that could speed up diagnosis and care for children with conditions such as cerebral palsy, epilepsy and learning difficulties. [BBC]
- No link between paracetamol in pregnancy and autism or ADHD in children, review finds: Publication of the work was fast-tracked to provide prospective mothers and their doctors with reliable information. [The Guardian]
- → Medical training in England needs major overhaul, says landmark review: This year there were 91 999 applications made in England for 12 833 specialty training posts (an overall competition ratio of 7), leaving many doctors unemployed. [BM]
- Covid raises risk of heart issues in children more than vaccination: The evidence that children were better off being vaccinated against covid-19 than getting infected by it during the pandemic just got even stronger. [New Scientist]
- ⇒ Flu deaths exceed COVID as vaccination rates plummet: More than 10 per cent of Australia's infections are occurring in children under five. [Health Times]
- ⇒ Type 1 diabetes is worse in the young here's why: Study shows it is down to the development of the beta cells living in the pancreas. [BBC]
- Introducing the j-metric: a true measure of what matters in academia: Science has become obsessed with publishing numbers. With this new satirical proposal, have we reached peak metric?. [Nature]
- ➡ Break the silence: let's start talking about COVID-19 again: When people stop hearing about COVID-19, they assume it's no longer a concern. Public health isn't just about vaccines and treatments; it's about trust and communication. [Croakey]

- → Al gets 45% of news wrong but readers still trust it: The researchers asked ChatGPT, Copilot, Gemini, and Perplexity about current events. 45% of the chatbot answers had at least one major issue. 31% were seriously wrong and 20% had major inaccuracies, from hallucinations or outdated sources. [Pivot to Al]
- ⇒ This machine could keep a baby alive outside the womb. How will the world decide to use it?: The entire field operates under a veil of secrecy ... scientists have agreed to collaboration meetings, then backed out. [The Guardian]
- ⇒ Al chatbots are sycophants researchers say it's harming science: Nature asked researchers who use artificial intelligence how its propensity for people-pleasing affects their work — and what they are doing to mitigate it. [Nature]
- → Powerful new antibiotic that can kill superbugs discovered in soil bacteria: Surprise discovery could pave the way for new treatments against drug-resistant infections. [Nature]
- ⇒ Peanut allergies have dropped dramatically in the US. Is that likely to happen in Australia?: Peanut allergy prevalence decreased from 0.79% in the 2012-14 cohort to 0.45% in the 2017-19 cohort, a 43% decrease. However, there are some limitations to the US study. [The Conversation]

Major UK project launched to tackle drug-resistant superbugs with AI: The project aims to speed up the discovery of fresh antibiotics and deliver new ways of killing other threats. [BBC]



- Can a social media detox help a young person with their mental health?: Among those participants who did a 1-week social media detox, deliberately reducing their use, the researchers say mental health symptoms reduced, especially for those who originally had more severe symptoms. [Scimex]
- ⇒ Picky eating is common and is linked to a risk of developmental difficulties: Australian researchers have now estimated that between 6 and 18% of kids eat such a narrow range of foods that they have symptoms of avoidant/restrictive food intake (ARFI) disorder. [Scimex]


